

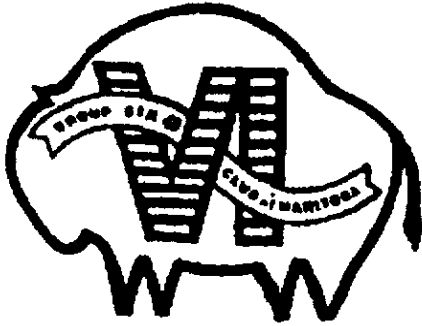

According to CKC rules, this class will be for 2 dogs of the same breed, not necessarily the same sex, handled by one person on one lead.

A Rosette will be presented to Best Brace in Specialty, the Breeder of the Specialty winner, all Winners, and Reserve Winners, In addition the club will support Obedience entries in Saturday's trial under Karen Banman with Rosettes and Prizes for High in Class(\$20) and High in Trial(\$50) by Group 6 dogs with qualifying scores as well as a rosette and prize(\$25) offered for Best Junior Handler (Group VI dog) in the MCA Junior Handling event.
